As the words go in the classic "Riverboat Shuffle" tune: YOU'RF INVITED TODAY......

To a special Flower City Jazz Evening JAM SESSION, MONDAY AUGUST 22nd, 6:30pm-9:30pm, at Radisson Hotel Rochester Airport, 175 Jefferson Rd, Rochester, NY 14623, hosted by the multitalented Jon Seiger and his trio. Jon is a veteran of many jamsession events, especially in the New York City area early in his career, so we're very pleased that he'll guide us thru this extraordinary musical evening. Jon's trio members will be Eric Metzgar on drums and Al Bruno on bass, both of whom have played with Jon extensively over recent years.

How's it work? <u>MUSICIANS</u> who want to <u>"sit-in"</u> for (four-or-five?) tunes (don't have to play all three hours) <u>can attend and get "free admission", by signing in and playing some time during the evening</u>. Jon will use the sign-in list to assemble various groups of sit-in players.
